SCOPE OF COMPETITION

HUNTING RIFLE SHOOTING according to the National Competition Rules for the Hunting Rifle Shooting discipline applicable as of 13. 2. 2022.

You can find the rules here:



30 shots (usually divided to 6×5 shots or $1 \times 10 + 4 \times 5$ shots) at different targets and gongs from different positions and using different supports.

ABSOLUTE COMPETITION RANKING WILL BE DETERMINED ACCORDING TO OVERALL RESULTS. THIS YEAR'S SELLIER & BELLOT MATCH ALLOWS REGISTRATION IN THE OPEN CATEGORY ONLY.

When registering for the competition in advance and paying the entry fee, the shooter can also order up to 200 Sellier & Bellot Match cartridges of the competition's calibre at a discounted price (calibres 222 Rem. and 223 Rem. - 22 CZK/pc, cal. 6.5 Creedmoor and 6.5 \times 55 SE - 25 CZK/pc, 308 Win. and 30–06 SPRG. - 27 CZK/pc).

Sellier & Bellot will guarantee the supply of ammunition by the date of the competition only if it is a firm order placed and paid by 30 June 2022.

If a registration is made and the entry fee paid from 1 July to 22 August 2022, the ammunition can be collected and paid in the Sellier & Bellot company shop in Vlašim after the end of the Sellier & Bellot Match 2022 competition and after a prior telephonic agreement with the shop manager, but no later than by 15. 12. 2022.

Shooters registered in advance will pay a discounted entry fee, as opposed to shooters who will register and pay the entry fee at the shooting range on the day of the competition.

All shooters registering at the place of the competition will be required to provide a proof of liability insurance for the use of a firearm. Members of the Czech and Moravian Gamekeeper Association (ČMMJ) shall provide a valid membership card with paid membership fees for 2022, gamekeepers (not members of ČMMJ) shall provide a proof of liability insurance for the performance of hunting rights for 2022, and members of ASAT shall provide a proof of paid membership fee for 2022. Other participants shall provide a proof of other insurance valid for 2022.

ENTRY FEE:

Basic entry fee applicable for registration after 22. 8. 2022 and payment on the date of the competition 1 200 CZK

Reduced entry fee applicable for registration and payment by 22. 8. 2022

Members of ČALKS 900 CZK Others 1 100 CZK

Sighting-in of firearms on Friday 26. 8. 2022 100 CZK

Schedule:

Friday 26. 8. 2022 17:30 – 19:00 check of firearm sighting-in

Saturday 27. 8. 2022 8:00 – 9:00 check of firearm sighting-in (max. 5 minutes per shooter)

8:00 - 9:00 attendance

9:30 opening ceremony – assembly

10:00 start of shooting

Technical provisions of the OPEN category:

- firing at fixed targets using a rifle (the use of semiautomatic firearms is prohibited), the lowest calibre for use is .20 (5 mm)
- the shooter shall use just one firearm (assembly)
- the rifle weight is not limited
- bipods are prohibited
- muzzle brakes and compensators are permitted (their use must be reported during registration to the competition)
- sound suppressors are permitted
- a sling attached with one end on the forestock (barrel) and the other on the shoulder stock is permitted
- gloves are permitted
- all types of hunting ammunition can be used (special military ammunition and ammunition with steel core is prohibited)
- a total of 30 shots are fired during one day, usually divided by 5 shots in six groups (the division can be different) the shooting distance is 50 to 400 metres (the distance will be known)
- a different time limit can be set for each group of shots. Usually 90 seconds, and 120 seconds at maximum. The time limit usually includes also the time of taking position on the shooting line
- all groups of shots allow the use of optics without magnification limits
- other provisions are governed by: National Competition Rules for the Hunting Rifle Shooting discipline applicable as of 13. 2. 2022, raising a protest deposit 500 CZK
- \circ each shooter's result will be expressed as a percentage of the result of the competition winner, the result of which will be 100 %

Assessment:

- within 30 minutes after the completion of shooting
- all groups of shots are evaluated together
- If the score for determining the first three places of the ranking is even, a shoot-out is conducted a gong with a diameter of 20 cm at a distance of 300 metres from the standing position, with unsupported hand (sudden death method). Shooters who hit the target continue by shooting at a gong with a diameter of 15 cm. Shooters who miss proceed to shooting at a distance of 250 m. Everything is repeated, and the distance is always 50 m shorter until the final ranking is decided.
